

The Flow Chart lets screening program coordinators see the 'flow' of babies through a Two Stage screening protocol. Two Stage protocols are designed to screen the baby with cheap and efficient technology (OAE) before the baby leaves the hospital (Inpatient, IP). If the baby is not screened or refers for more screening then the hospital makes appointments to have the mom and baby come back for Outpatient (OP) screening with a more advanced technology. There are three main sections to this report: Inpatient, Outpatient and Hearing Status (Evaluation). The Total # of infants at the top of the chart indicates how many infants are represented by this hospital. Facilities can be grouped as Birth Facilities or IP Screening Facilities. The OP section accounts for all infants who 'Referred', whose IP results were Inconclusive or who were 'Not Screened' during IP. The OP results are divided vertically into two sections representing these general categories. 'Atypical - > Dx' represents infants who have an evaluation in process or a confirmed loss (including Risk Monitoring) although they (1) Passed either IP or OP, (2) were not screened at IP or OP. For the Hearing Status section the Total Rec. for Evaluation includes infants who Referred OP, were marked as No OP -> Dx and babies who were atypically referred for Dx. Note: Hospitals giving Dx Recommendations of 'Monitor Risks' to Pass infants may see higher than expected numbers in the 'Atypical - > Dx' classification.
